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





Installation and Assembly


1. Attach M1 to Wheelchair back using F1 and F2 Tighten securely with wrench W2.




2. Place C1 onto A1 and insert A1 into M1. Tighten Knob.



3. Place C1 in desired position and tighten bolts with wrench W2.




4. Assemble B1, B2, R1 and A2 as shown. Tighten Bolts with Wrench W1.


To Install:

Image below shows installed device.




To Install (continued):

Step 1: Align C1 with holes in backrest. Install using bolts B1 and tighten securely.




Step 2: Attach Headrest Clamp (not included) using bolts B2 threaded into nuts N1.
